Landfill Disposals Tax Communities Scheme

The Landfill Disposals Tax Communities Scheme is a Welsh Government funding programme managed by the Welsh Council for Voluntary Action (WCVA). The scheme supports local community and environmental projects in areas affected by the disposal of waste to landfill. We are delighted that WCVA has decided that our project meets its objectives and has therefore awarded a substantial grant towards the costs.

The approved short summary of the project is reproduced below.

"This project will help to safeguard the future viability of this popular community hall and deliver lasting social and environmental benefits. The objective is to provide a new insulated roof to improve the condition of the building, and to commemorate its recovery from the problems caused by the Coronavirus pandemic."

We expect the work to commence during July or August and we ask for the patience and understanding of all users during the period that contractors are on site. There may be restricted entrance and exit points to the hall due to scaffolding and safety fencing. There may also be reduced car parking capacity and some unavoidable noise disruption at times.

Survival Funding for Voluntary Organisations

Our recovery from the pandemic has received financial support from the Third Sector Resilience Fund for Wales (Phase 2), which is managed and administered by WCVA on behalf of the Welsh Government.

Without this grant aid, we would have found it difficult to carry on as a viable concern. We are pleased to acknowledge the assistance we have been given.
