### The New Roof Project

The work to provide a new roof to the main hall has been delayed slightly, but is now expected to start this month. The erection of scaffolding will be the first visible signs on site and this will result in a few less car parking spaces being available for clients. The hall will remain open, but safety measures will be in operation and there will also be some noise disturbance at times.

**During the construction period, we ask for the patience and understanding of all users of the hall. Please take care and observe any safety instructions that may be issued by the contractors.**

### Precautionary Measures against COVID-19

We have recently relaxed a number of the conditions that we originally imposed on reopening, but clients are reminded that the pandemic is not yet over and that the specified hygiene measures should still be followed. Face coverings in indoor public places are currently a legal requirement in Wales for all those over the age of 11, except for medical exemptions or when exercising. The kitchen is available for basic use such as making hot drinks, but clients should continue to bring in their own refreshments if required.

### Review of Hire Charges for 2022

The committee will soon be reviewing our charges for next year and trying to maintain them at their current level. That would have been impossible without the resilience funding we received to help us survive the lockdowns, but will still be a challenge with the likely increase in costs. One concern is that our bank account will in future be charged for all cash and cheque transactions. Many of our clients already pay by direct bank transfer, so those who still pay by cash may like to consider switching to this method of payment over the coming months. We will continue to accept cash payments, but may eventually have to request a small surcharge to cover the cost to ourselves. All user groups will be informed about the charges for 2022 before the end of this year.

### Lighting and heating – help us to help you

It would make a difference to our energy bills if clients could check that only those lights needed for their use are switched on and that all lights are switched off before they leave the hall. As we approach the autumn and winter, please help us to ensure that the heating is on when needed and off when not needed. We try to set the heating clock as best we can, but please speak to the caretaker if you think the current arrangements could be improved.
